

WORDS OF THE HONORARY CHAIRPERSONS

The Ambassador of Finland

Dear Members of the Finnish Dutch Chamber of Commerce,

It is my pleasure to make my first contribution to the Annual Report, although we are facing difficult times. More than one year ago Russia started its military aggression of Ukraine and we are witnessing a full-scale war in Europe. Finland strongly condemns Russia's illegal invasion of Ukraine. It is a flagrant violation of international law. We firmly support Ukraine's independence, sovereignty, and territorial integrity.



The security environment in Europe has changed profoundly. Finland's decision to apply for NATO membership, together with Sweden, was based on a thorough assessment of the changed security situation."

War in Ukraine clearly illustrates the changing international landscape. In the current geopolitical situation topics like economic resilience, reducing strategic dependences, managing strategic risks and improving security are high on the European agenda. At the same time when safeguarding our economic interests we need to make sure not to sink into protectionism.

Finland and the Netherlands enjoy excellent bilateral relations at all levels and trade and business continues to be one in the heart of

these relations. The Netherlands has traditionally been one of our most important trading partner. War in Ukraine has given an extra momentum for green transition in Europe.

Circular economy, low carbon industry, energy transition or digitalization under the umbrella of sustainability are areas where Finland and the Netherlands can create partnerships and complement each other.

Tourism is showing new potential.

I also believe that in the field of security and defense we are able to find new avenues of cooperation. When it comes to promoting Finnish business in the Netherlands, the Finnish Dutch Chamber of Commerce continues to play a key role in bringing companies, organisations or potential partners together and facilitating networking.

The Embassy is ready to continue the excellent cooperation with the FDCC and other partners in order to further enhancing business and trade relations between our countries.

My first six months in the Netherlands have already confirmed me the vast business potential. Many new opportunities are there. However, we must not stay put in the comfort zone. We need to be open for new ideas and new ways of cooperation when promoting Finnish interests.

In this context, I would like to thank the FDCC for appointing me as the honorary chair. I look forward for communicating, connecting and cooperating with you. You can count on my and Embassy's support.

The Ambassador of the Netherlands

Many people, and indeed many entrepreneurs, had high hopes of 2022 as being the post-COVID recovery year. Instead, the Russian aggression in Ukraine changed our outlook completely, adding rising inflation and a challenging energy situation to today's geopolitical tensions. Finland went through a remarkable reorientation of its security policy with the decision to apply for NATO membership, a decision that was wholeheartedly supported by the Dutch Government.

Throughout the year, the Finnish Dutch Chamber of Commerce has continued to provide a valuable platform for companies from the Netherlands and Finland to get connected. In the past year, I had the pleasure of meeting many of you in person."

Domestic travelling was possible again, so I also used the opportunity to meet local businesses around Finland including members of the FDCC, for instance in Vaasa, Kuopio, Oulu, Rovaniemi and Turku.

The sustainable energy transition – that had already taken off – was fast-tracked in 2022. We also noticed this at the Embassy, as businesses signaled a growing interest to collaborate on topics such as hydrogen and off-shore wind.

I had the honour to host a 'hydrogen lunch' at the Dutch Residence in April, with some of Finland's key players in hydrogen. Moreover, we invited the Hydrogen Cluster Finland as well as BotH2nia to the World Hydrogen Summit in Rotterdam and the Offshore Energy Exhibition & Conference in Amsterdam. We are currently working on a market study to identify opportunities

for the Netherlands and the Nordics to collaborate on hydrogen.

The Province and City of Groningen organized an innovation mission to Sweden and Finland in May 2022, with a delegation of more than 50 people, including local government officials, academia and business leaders. In Finland, Groningen visited Vaasa and Espoo, to identify and deepen collaboration on topics such as hydrogen, mobility and human capital. We are happy to see that the visit has already lead to further interaction between the Finnish and Dutch parties involved.

The embassy's activities also continued on circular economy, for instance at the Nordic Circular Summit. We also hosted a Dutch session at the World of Digital Built Environment Summit, with the topic of 'Building within boundaries of our planet'.

Start-up event Slush was one of the year's highlights. With the Netherlands Enterprise Agency RVO, and 4 Dutch technical universities, we brought a record number of Dutch companies to Finland, over 70 startups and almost 200 people. It was all about responsible tech.

Looking forward, sustainable trade remains at the core of the embassy's activities.

In 2023, for instance, the World Circular Economy Forum (WCEF) will take place in Helsinki, the Netherlands being one of the event's key partners.

The embassy has also undertaken a twoyear research project for digitalization, which is about to be concluded. The project has entailed mapping out the latest developments and ambitious goals in the Finnish digitalization policy as well as finding opportunities for collaboration between Finnish and Dutch companies, business hubs, universities and other organizations.



The sectors identified as being of particular interest with many opportunities for collaboration are cybersecurity, telecom, quantum computing and smart mobility & cities."

Already in January 2023, we kicked off the year with the FDCC patrons' dinner in Helsinki. Further exciting activities are in the making for this year. I am always interested in hearing your ideas and thoughts on what is happening in Dutch-Finnish trade and investment. I look forward to seeing as many of you as possible in 2023 – let us stay connected!

Words of the FDCC Chairperson

Dear Members of the Chamber, 2022 saw the pandemic subsiding, and as such, enabling a (partial) return to more face to face activities, a report of which you will find in this annual report. Activities such as the Young Professional network aim to attract future members into the FDCC and enable further cultural exchanges between Finns and Dutch alike.

Activities such as the exchange of work experiences of Dutch people working in Finland or Finns working in the Netherlands aim to open up the emotions attached to working in a country (far) away from home, irrespective of how similar the two countries might be.



As such these events aim to bring a more personally relatable element in the bilateral cooperation between Finland and the Netherlands."

Financially the last book year has resulted in the FDCC taking a small financial loss due to the investments in a.o. marketing and documentation, both of which have the aim of enlarging the reach of the FDCC and keeping members better up to date in terms of events and sharing in the experience, even when not able to physically join.

With the war in Ukraine Finland has taken more centre stage in many European minds and on the military side of things the delivery a few years back of the bulk of the Dutch Leopard tanks to Finland highlighted the enduring importance of

the bilateral relationships and what small countries can achieve when working together in defending values both Finland and the Netherlands hold in high regards, such as freedom and independence.

2023 has started well with a (re)start of the annual Patron dinner, hosted for Finnish/Dutch business leaders at the Dutch ambassador´s residence in Helsinki, Villa Kleineh, with the next patron dinner scheduled in June for Finnish/Dutch business leaders located in the Netherlands.

One of the highlights for 2023 will be the Finland BeNeLux summit in Helsinki on June 7th, for those of you working in Clean

Tech, Health Tech or Smart cities / mobility industries, aiming to bring together some 200 professionals across Finland, Netherlands, Belgium and Luxembourg. On behalf of the entire board, I wish you a great 2023 year and hope to meet in person in one of the many events lined up for you during this upcoming year.

Young Professionals

Joined the FDCC board as a Young Professionals Coordinator in April 2022. In addition to regular Chamber activities, I have focused on strengthening further the Young Professionals community of the FDCC. Our aim is to build a network for young professionals operating in the Dutch-Finnish business environment by providing a forum to connect and develop professionally.

The efforts so far have to a great extent been made possible thanks to the support of the fantastic FDCC interns. I would like to once more thank my colleagues Elsa, Riia, Laura, Ronja and Alexandra for all the work done with the YP in 2022.

The idea behind the Nordic Young Professionals community is driven by the mindset of achieving more together.

In 2022, we utilized the post-COVID environment where people were energized to meet by organizing three events. We started with an introductory event, the Nordic Reunion, on April 21. The FDCC corporate member DolkHesper hosted us at their premises in the Kamer van Koophandel building in the very center of Amsterdam.

Finnish participation was strong with a quarter of the guests already being members of the FDCC, and together with non-members, Finns stood for almost half of the participants. During the event, the



new YP Coordinators did introductions and we met a lot of new people. I was happy to make new connections and have interesting

discussions on cultural differences and on working and studying in the Netherlands. Additionally, on June 8 we organized another event, the Pre-summer Drinks, at Barlow in the Hague. This was a more casual afterwork-themed event to kick off the summer and to network among Nordic young professionals before the holidays. Over half of the

participants were Finns, both students and young professionals.

We see that our members are also based in cities like the Hague, Rotterdam and Utrecht, and as an organization we want to be inclusive and accessible to young professionals around the country.

With two events behind us, one in Amsterdam and another one in the Hague, we decided to organize the third event in Rotterdam. On September 28, the Nordic Young Professionals gathered in the bar Mavis for another informal afterwork with the theme Back from Summer.




In 2023, we will put increasing focus in providing our members with tools for career and competence development."



I'm looking forward to further cherishing the many connections the FDCC has offered both personally and professionally! Wishing you all a great and successful year ahead!



Nordic Reunion: Young Professionals Event - 21.04.2022


Nordic Reunion was the first Young










Young Professionals Back from Summer - 28.09.2022




Finnish Independence Day Celebration- 10.12.2022



Words of the Treasurer

Please find the financial and operational performance of the FDCC in short for 2022. The income from membership fees increased in 2022 from 2021 due to the one of discount that was applied during the pandemic when most events were virtual.



As the goal of the Chamber is to service its members with events and content that interest our members we are glad we again are able to arrange such outside our homes."

The Finnish Dutch Chambers aim is still to increase the number of members in the years to come by continuously developing the events offered.

The membership fees are the main source of income and are vital for continuing the FDCC activities. Income from the membership fees in 2022 was € 25 026 which was as budgeted, while the expenses were € 27 976.

During this anniversary year more events were arranged than during the pandemic years and most events were also free of charge which resulted in an overspend of 2200 € against the original budget.

This will be booked against the reservation of 6000 € made in the beginning of the year for this purpose, by releasing 2500€.

Other budgeted costs were as expected. The balance at the beginning of the year was

> 23 749 € and at the closing of the year 20 103 €.

The FDCC continues to post the plans for 2023 on socialmedia and on our homepage.

Overall, the Chamber is financially stable and has an equity position to continue and futher develop its activities in the years to come.






